Subject to conditions prescribed by UC Davis Health, Facilities Planning & Development, sealed bids for a lump-sum contract are invited for the following work:

CUP GENERATOR CONTROLLER REPLACEMENTS

Description of Work:

This project includes the replacement and modernization of the existing generator control and monitoring systems, including upgrading analog electronic-based generator controllers to new digital Woodward controllers and replacing aging ASCO generator control cabinet components one generator at a time to maintain campus power reliability. The scope also includes replacing CAT engine monitors with new monitoring equipment and modifying Generator 6's power distribution system to allow sequential generator shutdowns without interrupting essential campus power. During the generator control replacement, temporary support for essential loads will be provided by spare 3MW Generator 6 located at David Tower; refer to page E000 for the construction phasing sequence. Additional work includes coordination with UC Davis Health Plant Operations and Maintenance (PO&M), stakeholder engagement, pre-bid site observation walks, and coordination with concurrent campus projects, including the Central Utility Plant Expansion and medium-voltage switchgear work, to ensure uninterrupted operations and safe project execution.

Bidder Qualifications: To be eligible for consideration of award, bidders must have the minimum experience set forth in the Supplementary Instructions to Bidders. Bidders must submit the qualification documents as an attachment to the Bid Form.

Bidders must attend a **MANDATORY** pre-bid conference at **11 a.m., Monday, June 29, 2026**. Participants shall meet at Facilities Planning & Development (916-734-7024), 4800 2nd Avenue, Suite 3010, Sacramento, CA 95817. Bidders must be present at the pre-bid conference no later than the scheduled start time in order to bid as a Prime Contractor and must attend both the conference and job walk in their entirety. Attendees should plan to arrive at least 45 minutes prior to the scheduled meeting time to arrange for parking, as spaces are very limited at the campus. Bid Deadline/Opening: Sealed bids must be received on or before 2 p.m., Monday, July 20, 2026.

Estimated Construction Cost: \$2,540,000.00

Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the Lump Sum Base Bid, excluding alternates, shall accompany each Bid. The Surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the Bid Deadline, an admitted surety insurer (as defined in California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120).

The successful Bidder will be required to have the following California current and active contractor's license at the time of submission of the Bid: **A – General Engineering Contractor** or **B -General Construction**

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each Bidder may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy. The successful Bidder and its subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wages at the location of the work.

In addition, the University is committed to promoting and increasing participation of small business enterprises (SBEs) and disabled veteran business enterprises (DVBES) relating to all goods and services covered under the awarded agreement, subject to any and all applicable obligations under state and federal law, and University policies. The work described in the contract is a public work subject to section 1771 of the California Labor Code.

No contractor or subcontractor, regardless of tier, may be listed on a Bid for, or engage in the performance of, any portion of this project, unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 and 1771.1. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The successful Bidder shall pay all persons providing construction services and/or any labor on site, including any University location, no less than the highest of UC Fair Wage; California Minimum Wage; and Local Minimum Wage; and shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local working condition requirements.
